MEMORIAL PLAQUE INFORMATION – HIGH HOLY DAYS 5777 / 2016

To commemorate the lives of our loved ones, members often choose to purchase an engraved memorial plaque which is placed on the memorial boards in the sanctuary.

In accordance with tradition, Yahrzeit plaques are illuminated on the anniversary of the date of death and on festival holidays when Yizkor is recited.

Dedication of new memorial plaques added to our memorial wall between the 2015/5776 High Holy Days and July 2016 takes place during the Selichot service on Saturday, September 24 at 8:00 p.m.

To have a plaque on the memorial board in time for the Selichot service on Saturday, September 24, your form must be received in the Temple office by August 15.

If returned to the Temple office between August 16 and September 1, your memorial plaque will be installed in time for the Simchat Torah Festival service with Yizkor on Monday, October 24.
